SUB: NOTICE OF ELECTION SCHEDULE AND CALL FOR AFFILIATED MEMBERS TO FILE APPLICATIONS TO NOMINATE THEIR RESPECTIVE REPRESENTATIVES FOR PARTICIPATION AND/ OR CONTEST IN THE ELECTION TO THE DECLARED VACANT POSTS IN THE 95TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION SCHEDULED TO BE HELD ON 24/09/2026

In exercise of powers under Rule 62 of the CAB Rules, the Electoral Officer appointed by the Cricket Association of Bengal ("CAB") hereby invites Affiliated Members of the CAB including the former international cricketers to submit applications to have their respective representatives ("Representatives") [or themselves in the case of former international cricketers] included in the Electoral Roll for the Election to be held at **THE 95TH Annual General Meeting** of the CAB, on 24/09/2026 for the **FOLLOWING VACANT POSTS, AS PER DECLARED VACANCIES :**

- A. Two Posts of Office Bearers i.e. the Secretary and the Joint Secretary**
- B. One Post of Councillor of the Apex Council**

1. The CAB Election process shall be conducted in accordance with the Schedule provided in Table 1 below ("Election Schedule").

2. In order for a Representative of an Affiliated Member to be considered for inclusion in the Electoral Roll for the CAB Election, the Affiliated Member shall be required to

submit an application as specified below within the deadline(s) specified for receipt of such Applications in the Election Schedule. **(03/09/2026 to 16/09/2026) giving 7 clear days' time before the AGM on 24/09/2026.**

- a. A Representation & Nomination Form has to be submitted in the prescribed **APPENDIX 'A'** (enclosed with the Notice for the Annual General Meeting) duly completed, signed by the Secretary/General Secretary of the Affiliated Member and the Chairman of the Meeting for Affiliated Members only (this requirement is not applicable for Former International Cricketers). Signature by any other Office Bearer will not be accepted. **Any overwriting or cancellation of any entry should normally be avoided. In case of unavoidable circumstances resulting in such overwriting or cancellation, the same shall have to be authenticated by the Secretary/General Secretary with his signature.** Once Appendix 'A' and Nomination-cum- Affidavit in Form A have been submitted to the Office, the same cannot be cancelled/revised/replaced on any ground whatsoever.
- b. The Appendix 'A' Form along with the Notice for the Annual General Meeting and Notice of Election Schedule will be sent only at the recorded address as per the Registrar of Members maintained by the Cricket Association of Bengal. **Such Notice sent by appropriate postal agency/ courier, including Notice sent by email to the registered email address (if available with the Office of CAB) of the Affiliated Members will be taken as proper Notice and deemed to have been duly served (in terms of Rule 20 and 71 of the CAB Rules).**
- c. **In all such cases of service, no duplicate Notice or Form will be issued.**
- d. The Appendix-A Form must be signed by the Honorary Secretary/ Hony. General Secretary of the Affiliated Member as stated above **,Only such Appendix 'A' Form and Form A, which are compliant with the above, will be taken as valid. These Forms have to be accompanied with a copy of the resolution passed by the appropriate nominating/ appointing authority of the Representative as per the Affiliated Member's Constitution.**
- e. Detailed Time Schedule is mentioned in the Election Schedule above.
- f. In order to be considered as a valid Intending Candidate for a vacant post as per the declared vacancies of the Association, the said Intending Candidate (Being a Representative of an Affiliated Member of CAB whose name is included in finally published Electoral Roll) has to submit the following Forms and Documents to the Office of Electoral Officer, CAB as per the period prescribed in the Election Schedule in addition to the Appendix 'A' Form with relevant columns, as mentioned in the schedule above, duly filled in and the Form duly signed by the respective officials:

- i. A Nomination-cum Affidavit in Form A by the Intending Candidate in the prescribed Form (enclosed herewith) duly signed by the Intending Candidate and attested by a Notary/Oath Commissioner positively by 5-00 P.M. on or before 16/09/2026.
 - ii. Self-attested copy of any of the Identification and age proof documents like the following: Voter Card/ Passport/ Driving License/ Aadhar Card/ PAN Card/ Birth Certificate of Authorised Representative.
 - iii. Self-attested copy of PAN Card of Authorised Representative.
 - iv. A copy of the Resolution passed by the appropriate nomination/appointing authority of the Representative, as per the Affiliated Member's constitution.
3. Originals of all application and self- attested copies of the documents are required to be submitted to the Office of the *Electoral Officer of The CAB* at the Address specified below and are required to reach such Address before 5-00 P.M. on or before 16/09/2026 along with the Nomination-cum-Affidavit Form A and Appendix 'A'.

4. Affiliated Members are advised to adhere to timelines specified in Paragraph 1, Paragraph 2 and Paragraph 3 for submission of the applications by Affiliated Members to the Electoral Officer, CAB.
5. Affiliated Members are advised to take the necessary care, and conduct due diligence, while nominating their Representatives to participate in the CAB Election, as per their constitutional documents, the Memorandum & Rules of CAB and orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard. Representatives and candidates of affiliated members will be disqualified from attending and participating at the Annual General Meeting and/or contesting as candidates for any of the vacant posts in the event of such persons being disqualified and/or ineligible under the rules and regulations of CAB.
6. A Representative will be deemed to be eligible to participate in the CAB election on behalf of his/her Affiliated Member only if the application is filed in Appendix 'A'. Such person will be eligible to contest in the election on behalf of the Affiliated Member, if the application in Appendix 'A' and Nomination-cum-Affidavit in Form-A meet all the requirements specified and include all the documentation prescribed above and the Electoral Officer is satisfied that such person is not disqualified under the applicable Rules. At the Annual General Meeting, a representative of an Affiliated Member (other than a Former International Cricketer) shall submit a letter signed

by the Honorary Secretary of the Affiliated Member authorising the Representative whose name is mentioned in Appendix 'A' to attend the meeting, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to attend the meeting.

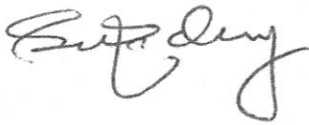
7. In the event that the Electoral Officer, CAB deems a proposed Representative to be ineligible to attend the Annual General Meeting and/or participate in the CAB Election and/or contest as a candidate, it will not be possible for the Affiliated Member to nominate a replacement. Therefore, it is essential that all formalities are duly complied with by the Affiliated Member and the proposed Representative as per requirements.
8. The Electoral Officer reserves the right to require further information or seek clarification on and in respect of any matter relating to the CAB Election.
9. In case of any disputes or objection arising with respect to the CAB Election, from the stage of declaration or publication of draft electoral roll of qualified members to the stage of declaration of results, including but not limited to objections to Appendix 'A', candidacy, disqualification, eligibility to vote or the admission or rejection of a vote, the Electoral Officer, CAB shall decide the same and such a decision shall be final and conclusive.
10. The Candidates as per the declared vacancies of the Association shall be elected by the Affiliated Members of the Association from amongst their Representatives and by the Former International Cricketers present at the Annual General Meeting. **Only one authorised Representative of an Affiliated Member and each Former International Cricketers are entitled to attend and participate in the Annual General Meeting on 24/09/2026 and an authorised Representative of the Affiliated Member and each Former International Cricketer is entitled to contest in the election to only one of the Vacant Posts of the Association.** An Intending Candidate shall have to submit Nomination-cum-Affidavit in Form A duly filled in and signed as per schedule and the same shall be submitted by such authorised Representatives of the Affiliated Members of the Association who fulfils the criteria prescribed in CAB Rules. **The Nomination-cum-Affidavit in Form-A shall positively be attested by a Notary Public/ Oath Commissioner.**
11. No person shall be a Proposer to more than one candidate in respect of one post. Likewise, no person shall be a Seconder to more than one Candidate in respect of one post.
12. The Nomination-cum-Affidavit in Form A shall have to be filled in only by the nominated Candidate of the Affiliated Member authorised to contest the election and not by the Representative of the Affiliated Members only intending to attend the Annual General Meeting scheduled to be held on 24/09/2026, similarly for Former International Cricketers.

13. The Nomination-cum-Affidavit in Form A has to be submitted either by the Candidate or by his/her Proposer, in person, as per the scheduled dates and time.
14. On the appointed day, the scrutiny of Nomination papers will be taken up in presence of the Candidate or if the candidate is absent, in presence of his/her Proposer. In case of their absence, the process of scrutiny will nonetheless continue and be completed in their absence. No other person shall be permitted to be present during the process of scrutiny. The Electoral Officer will announce a List of Validly Nominated Candidates for declared Vacant Posts as per the Schedule of Election drawn up and given above.
15. A validly Nominated Candidate will be allowed to withdraw from the contest till the time allowed for such withdrawal by filing his/her Withdrawal Application in the prescribed form in person before the Electoral Officer.
16. On the stipulated Day, the Electoral Officer after taking into account the withdrawals, if any, of such validly nominated Candidates from the contest shall announce the list of Contesting Candidates for the post to which election is scheduled to be held. **In case of non -submission of any Nomination pertaining to the election to a Vacant Post, the subsequent stages of the election process will be cancelled by the Electoral Officer.**
17. The Electoral Officer shall cause arrangements to be made for Voting by the Representatives of eligible Affiliated Members on the Election date for the vacant Posts only to which election is scheduled to be held in the event of more than One Nomination being received for such Posts. Only the eligible voters as per the Rules & Regulations of CAB and as allowed under the Election Procedure by the Electoral Officer will remain present in or near the Election Venue. The eligible Representatives of Affiliated Members will exercise their voting rights in respect of each of the contested posts.
18. The Electoral Officer will prescribe the procedure for the Representatives to cast their vote including but not limited to the Ballot, its design, its authentication, the maintenance of Secrecy of Ballot, the time limit for exercising the voting right, the time period for preservation of counted Ballots and other Election materials etc.
19. At the closure of the time prescribed for the Poll, the Electoral Officer shall cause the counting of the Ballot papers and announce the Results in respect of the Contested Posts.
20. After announcement of Results, the Electoral Officer shall announce the completion of the Poll Process.

21. A code of conduct covering all the Activities relating to Elections is enclosed for guidance and compliance by all Members including Candidates.

22. A model procedure of Campaign is also enclosed for guidance and compliance by all concerned.

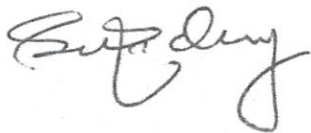

MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR GUIDANCE OF OFFICE BEARERS; COUNCILLORS; AFFILIATED MEMBERS AND THEIR REPRESENTATIVES AND CANDIDATES FOR THE ENSUING ELECTION ON 24/09/2026 FROM THE ELECTORAL OFFICER, APPOINTED TO CONDUCT ELECTION IN TERMS OF RULE 62 OF THE CAB RULES TO THE POSTS OF HONORARY SECRETARY AND HONARARY JOINT SECRETARY, TWO OF THE OFFICE BEARERS AND ONE POST OF COUNCILLOR OF THE APEX COUNCIL OF THE CRICKET ASSOCIATION OF BENGAL.

1. From the time elections are announced, the Apex Council comprising of its Office Bearers and Councillors shall not sanction any grants out of the funds of the Cricket Association of Bengal and shall not announce any financial grant in any form, shall not make any promise for according any new facilities, make any adhoc appointments or confer any benefits which may have the effect of influencing the electors.
2. The Office of the Cricket Association of Bengal will undertake only routine work. The Apex Council shall not take any new policy decision in any meeting till the election process is over.
3. In order to ensure free and fair polls and transparency, as envisaged in the Memorandum and in the Rules and Regulations ("Constitution") of CAB, candidates are required to file the Nomination Papers along with an affidavit/declaration covering provisions mentioned therein. Nominations received without the affidavit/declaration will be rejected at the time of scrutiny.
4. If Election is required to be held for the Elective Posts, **the period between 05-00 p.m. of 22nd September, 2026 and 05-00 p.m. of 24th September, 2026** would be designated as the "Campaign Period" to enable candidates to seek support of members of CAB in their favour on the Voting Day. The Campaign Period may be used for Candidates for Campaigning. **However, from the date of announcement of the election, all administrators, as defined in the Rules of CAB,as wellas the candidates shall scrupulously avoid all activities which are corrupt practices under the election law such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, canvassing within 100 meters aroundthe precincts of the Office of CAB at Dr. B. C. Roy Club House and the venue for the AGM including holding of any formal/informal meetings with Representatives of Affiliated Members and Former International Cricketers to influence the election process.**
5. **All administrators, as defined in the Rules of CAB,as well as the candidates shall scrupulously avoid appealing to any religious or caste sentiments or distribution of gifts of any kind to induce members for support. They will strictly adhere to the prescribed campaign practices annexed to these instructions.**
6. Candidates will not use vehicles to bring members to the voting venue on the date of polling.CAB will also not provide any vehicle to the Representatives of Affiliated Members/ Former International Cricketers.

7. Proxy voting shall not be allowed. **Only the Authorised Representatives of the Affiliated Members, whose names are mentioned in the finally published Electoral Roll and Former International Cricketers, will be eligible to cast their votes.**
8. Pamphlets and posters, if circulated should not appeal to religious, caste, or communal sentiments to lure voters. If pamphlets/ posters are put up, they should be not violative of any Law in force.
9. No pamphlets/posters/banners are allowed to be used/ put up, in or around 100 meters **around the precincts of the Office of CAB at Dr. B. C. Roy Club House and the venue for the AGM** i.e. the venue of the voting.
10. Candidates will maintain peace and calm in the voting venue during the polling period in order to maintain law and order.
11. Campaign office/platform will not be opened in and around the Venue of Voting.
12. All Candidates are expected to cooperate with the Electoral Officer for smooth conduct of voting during the entire process.
13. As stipulated in CAB Memorandum & the Rules, "In case of any dispute or objection as to candidacy, disqualification, eligibility to vote or admission or rejection of a vote in the elections to the Apex Council or any of the Committees, the Electoral Officer shall decide the same and such decision shall be final and conclusive".

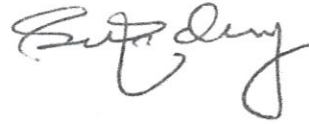
CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

FOR GUIDANCE OF OFFICE BEARERS; COUNCILLORS; AFFILIATED MEMBERS AND THEIR REPRESENTATIVES AND CANDIDATES FOR THE ENSUING ELECTION ON 24/09/2026

FROM: THE ELECTORAL OFFICER

1. Electoral Campaigns shall be carried out by or on behalf of Candidates in a fair and reputable manner and, more generally, in a spirit of respect for fundamental ethical principles.
2. Candidates shall conduct all Campaigns with dignity and moderation and with due respect to other candidates, the CAB and its Members. A Candidate should not speak, write or make any representation of any nature likely to harm the image of another candidate or cause his/her prejudice. Criticism of other candidates, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programmes, past record and work. Criticism based on unverified allegations or distortion shall be avoided. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes.
3. Each Candidate may present to the electoral college his/her plans and views for the post, in the form of a written document, whatever the means used to distribute it.
4. Candidates shall avoid excessive expenditure in campaigning, recognising that could become a factor of inequality amongst the candidates.
5. All Candidates shall avoid scrupulously all activities that are "corrupt practices", such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, etc.
6. Candidates may, in no case and under no pretext give presents, offer donations or gifts or grant advantages of whatever nature, directly or indirectly, to voting members or their representatives.
7. As the Voting is secret, Voting Members are prohibited individually or collectively, from announcing publicly in any form whatsoever their intention to Vote or not to Vote for a Candidate.
8. The incumbent Office Bearers and/or Councillors of the Apex Council shall ensure that no cause is given for any complaint that they/he/she used their/his/ her official position for the purposes of their or his or hers or others' election campaign and in particular shall not (a) use CAB transport including, vehicles, machinery and personnel for furtherance of their campaign; (b) issue any advertisement at the cost of the CAB or its Members in the newspapers and other media or misuse the CABs official media channels during the elections; and (c) sanction grants out of CAB funds from the time elections are announced.
9. The management and administrative staff of CAB shall maintain neutrality at all times starting from the date of issue of Election Notification and till the whole process is

declared closed. No support or service in relation to a Candidature be given by any Member of the CAB's administrative or executive staff.



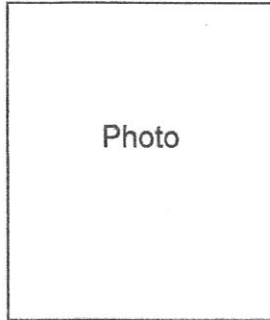
