I would like to draw your kind attention to the fact, that cricket season 2022-2023 is now slated to begin and the Cricket Association of Bengal (member of the BCCI) taking steps to organise the cricket tournament for various age groups such as Under-13, Under-15, Under-19 boys.

Now, the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has framed guidelines *inter alia* for the registration of the players under various age groups. In order to tackle age and domicile fraud in cricket, the BCCI has directed the State Associations to register the players on the basis of the details as recorded in the Digital Birth Certificate issued by the competent authority.
