**Subject:** Complaint regarding infractions in the administration and governance and non-submission of documents mentioned in Rule 53 (d) of the CAB Rules as approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India of ARYAN CLUB as well as incorrect representations made in the form submitted by ARYAN CLUB in 'Appendix –A' for the purpose of attending the last scheduled AGM and SGM of CAB.

## Order No. 1 dated 19th July, 2025.

Since the complaint is addressed to Apex Council, let the complaint of Mr. Dhanraj Prasad and another dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 along with the representation of the Hony. Joint Secretary of the Aryan Club dated 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2025, be referred to the Apex Council which will take its decision on the aforesaid complaint of the complainant on its own merit.

It is made clear that while referring the complaint of the complainant and/or the representation of the Hony. Joint Secretary of the Aryan Club to the Apex Council, the undersigned has not considered as to whether such a dispute is entertainable under Rule 70 of the Memorandum and Rules of the Cricket Association of Bengal. As such the question of locus of the complainant to maintain such an application before the Apex Council and/or the jurisdiction of the Apex Council to entertain such complaint of the complainant, are left open to be decided by the Apex Council.

It is further made clear that while referring the above complaint and/or representation to the Apex Council, the undersigned has not considered the merit of the complaint and/or the representation submitted by the respective parties. As such the Apex Council is free to take its own decision on the complaint as referred to above.

The matter is disposed of.

CAB is directed to communicate this order to all concerned, at the earliest.
