Mr. Banerjee, learned Senior Counsel appearing for NCC has submitted one application, praying for dismissal of the above complaint no. 1 (OMB) of 2026. He has also submitted another application for dismissal and/or stay of this proceeding for non-compliance of the direction of the erstwhile Ombudsman regarding filing of the affidavit in support of the statements made in the complaint.

Let both the aforesaid applications be kept with the records.

It is clarified that both the applications of NCC for dismissal of the above complaint of the complainant are taken up for hearing along with the complaint of the complainant

It is pointed out that there is a common issue regarding allotment of tickets to NCC by CAB in both the complaints being No. as 9 (OMB) of 2025 (Mr. Madhusudan Das Mundhra&Ors. – Complainants) and the complaint no. 1 (OMB) of 2026 ( Mr. PrabhatJhawar –Complainant). It is also pointed out that in the complaint of Mridul Beria (Case No. 13 (OMB) of 2025), incidentally the same question which is involved in those proceedings, will also be addressed. Accordingly, all the above three proceedings which are being heard today on the above issue, will also be heard on 3rd February, 2026 at 9 p.m. at Bengal Club, at Room No. 150.
